All flags are 30" x 60", double sided, and made of high-quality durable vinyl printed with the American flag, a choice of either a photo of your honoree or an image of a circle of 13 stars surrounding a silhouette of a Minuteman to give a nod to our 250th anniversary, and your specific message. The purchase of a flag is good for (2) seasons from date of purchase, which spans from Memorial Day to Veterans Day each year, at the end of which the flag will be returned to the purchaser for their reuse and enjoyment.

If you want your flag to include a photo of your honoree you have two choices for submission in order to ensure a quality result:



The appearance of these flags, in the center of Town and along the Memorial Day Parade route, adds to the solemnity of our Memorial Day Parade, as well as honors the participation of friends and family in the defense of our country.

To participate, we ask any Mendon resident interested to complete the Flag Purchase Form and mail the form along with a check for \$250 to PO Box 551, Mendon, MA 01756.

The completed form along with payment must be received by March 29th, 2026, to allow for adequate processing time. There is a maximum of 52 flags which will be assigned first come, first served.

Design Options

Flags can be dedicated to a specific individual(s) or a more generic message.

Flags for a specific individual can include the service person's name, branch of service, and any conflicts or theatres in which he/she served.

The design is still being finalized, but the final products will look substantially as these examples. The one on the left is the "honoree portrait" image option and the one to the right is the silhouette minuteman option.
